## WHAT WE DO & HOW IT WORKS

Our nonprofit, all-volunteer organization serves the people of Maui County primarily through support to our libraries. Maui Friends of the Library (MFOL) uses the money from store sales, donations, pop-up sales, and memberships to fund the cost of new materials and ongoing programs in Maui County's public libraries — items which often fall short on the state library budget.

***As an all-volunteer organization, 100% of net receipts go directly to libraries...and back into our community.***

Every year, MFOL supplements the budget of each branch library in Maui County, so they can purchase new materials: books, periodicals, reference materials, CDs, DVDs. MFOL funding also helps the libraries present community programming for all ages: story times, music performances, talks, and workshops.

## BOOKS FOR ALL!

There is a side benefit to MFOL's fundraising activities: we are able to give all people on Maui access to inexpensive books and media. Whether for education, self-improvement, or entertainment, MFOL offers a place where *everyone* can afford a book, movie, or music. Our stores are filled with donated books, CDs DVDs, audio books, magazines, and games; we sell the merchandise at reasonable prices to raise much-needed funds for our libraries.

# PU'UNĒNĒ

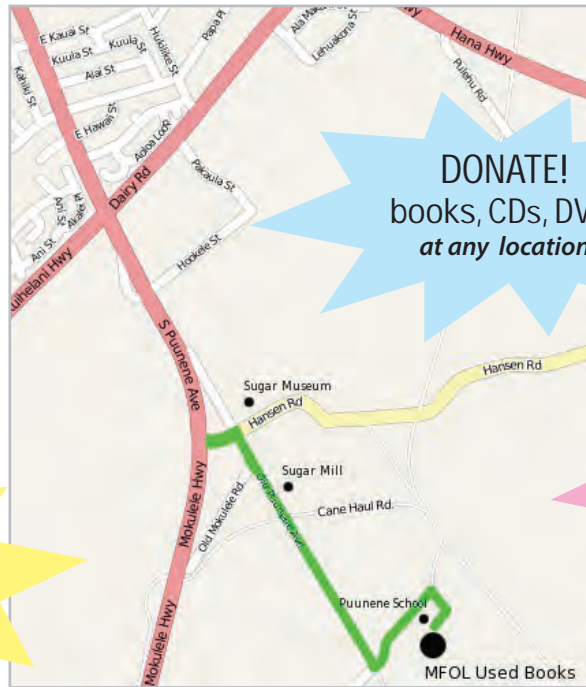
